The doctrine of the Blessed Trinity

is a mystery and the most important of all the mysteries. Our lives in the Church began with baptism in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. One God in three persons, a truth that escapes our ability to comprehend. Only with Faith can we come to understand even a little what this means: God does not dwell in solitude. In His intimacy, He is a family: paternity, filiation, and love.

This tremendous mystery has been revealed to us by the Son, the second person of the Blessed Trinity who took on human flesh. He showed us the Father and after his ascension the "love of God has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit which has been given us." A gift of love who allows us to call God our Father and confess that Jesus is Lord.

The first cosmonaut could not see God in space perhaps because he lived in country that officially was far from Him on earth. Are we any better placed in our own times? How often do we consider the indwelling of the Blessed Trinity within our soul? This consoling belief is a great help in our struggle. God is not far from us, He remains with us – to the consummation of the age – as the Book of Proverbs makes clear "ever at play in His presence, at play everywhere in the world, delighting to be with the sons of men." The Blessed Trinity delights to be with us, and with our concerns. We should be aware of the saving effects of Jesus' passion within us. We should call God Father. We should see the work of the Holy Spirit in events.
