Annual Vinnies CEO Sleep Out

Last Thursday night I took part in the annual Vinnies CEO sleep out to see some of what Catholics in Sydney are doing at the peripheries in their apostolate to the broader Australian society.

Previous to the snores and dew soaked cardboard of a night under the stars on the concrete wharf, the St Vincent de Paul Society welcomed hundreds of CEO's and leaders into a pavilion where they introduced us to people who have experienced homelessness but been brought back into accommodation by society members. In all cases we were dealing with ordinary families that had hit hard times and did not want to be split up. One lady could not bring her 13 year old son with her into the women's refuge. Another family are from our own neck of the woods. The issue of affordable housing is a pressing one.

When the NSW president, Denis Walsh, addressed us, he told the assembled businesspeople what motivates all this good work. "Because we want to be close to God we reach out to our neighbour." Jack de Groot, the CEO, introduced us to the marvels of "It's Me" making use of AI, big data and personalised post office boxes for the homeless. It was great to see how a will to help and reach out could gather so many capable people together as a practical extension of the Gospel.

Over coffee and muesli provided by chirpy Vinnie's volunteers, Kumar Jha challenged me as a Church leader in Australia on the issue of homelessness and general solidarity with the marginalised. "Where is the initiative to form young Catholics in a social conscience? How are you holding the politicians to account?" Hailing from Delhi, Kumar could not fathom how 100,000 Australians sleep could be allowed to sleep rough in a First World country. In the call made by Pope Francis at the last World Youth Day, I would encourage our young leaders to 'get off the couch' and get involved in all manner of outreach through political and charity organisations.
