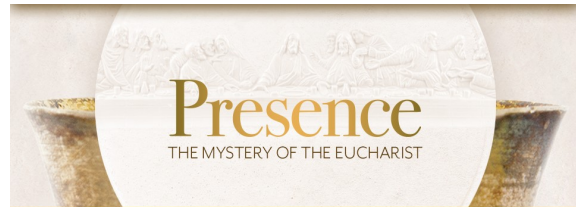

We all desire peace and happiness. But that external freedom from fuss and worry
depends in large part on our own inner peace. Not as a stoic who eats just the right
amount, goes to bed early, and sets their expectations low. Rather as a son or daughter of
God who trusts in God's fatherhood and seeks to please Him above all else. Jesus speaks
of the good father who keeps watch for the return of his prodigal son. God reveals
Himself as always waiting. Slow to anger, quick to forgive.

Like Father like son, we should cultivate patience. Think of how our patience is tried by
everything that puts an obstacle in the way of our doing what we want.

1. When we are kept waiting.
2. Repeating the same thing over and over to someone who just doesn't get it.
3. The scatterbrained actions of the irresponsible.

Being interrupted when we are only half way through saying what we want.

How do we react in each of these situations? The paradox of life is that only when we
resolve to put up with these things with good grace and humour that they no longer
become a burden to us. On the other hand, if we set out only to 'have a good time' then
we will inevitably encounter frustration.

The prayer of St Francis (though we do not know who actually wrote it) has been sung by
many of us in church, including Sinead O'Connor and Susan Boyle. Like St Paul's hymn
to charity it is at once deeply beautiful and very demanding.

Make me a channel of your peace
Where there is hatred let me bring your love
Where there is injury, your pardon Lord
And where there is doubt true faith in You

Make me a channel of your peace
Where there is despair in life let me bring hope
Where there is darkness only light
And where there's sadness ever joy

Oh, Master grant that I may never seek
So much to be consoled as to console
To be understood as to understand
To be loved as to love with all my soul
